Message from Head Teacher

We are delighted with the number of pupils who are regularly using Mathletics, Times Tables Rock Stars and Spellodrome to support their learning at home.

Every Monday, awards are presented in assembly to our Mathletics and Spellodrome 'Stars of the Week' and our 'Rock Heroes', and a list of pupils achieving gold certificates on Mathletics is displayed in the main reception area of school. We also have Times Tables Rocks Stars displays around school (Year 2 upwards). The list of Junior pupils working on and achieving the Platinum Bookworms award is also growing rapidly and these are also displayed on the Reading display by the School Office. Congratulations to everyone who is being resourceful and using these initiatives to develop their learning.

A reminder that all application forms for Nursery in September 2020 must be received in the school office by Friday, 20th March. This year, there are 20 '30-hour' places available for eligible families, as well as part-time morning or afternoon places. Please speak to Mrs Kerr in the School Office. Sutton Coldfield Charitable Trust


